WAIVER AND ORDER OF IN-PERSON COURT PROCEEDING

THE COURT HAVING ADDRESSED THE MINOR FINDS:

That the minor was advised of and understands that:

1. The minor has a right to be physically present in the courtroom for every substantive proceeding;
2. Remote appearance means the minor, the court, and other participants will participate via video or telephonic conferencing platforms;
3. Any remote appearance may be viewable by the public over the Internet or other method of streaming or broadcasting (if applicable and permitted by the presiding juvenile judge);
4. The minor and defense counsel may not be physically present together during the proceeding;
5. The legal effect of the remote appearance will be the same as an in-person appearance; and
6. The minor has discussed the waiver with counsel.

The Court further finds that doing so will not jeopardize the integrity of the trial process and that the minor was advised and understands that:

1. The video or telephonic conferencing platform being utilized is technically sound and its operation is understood by all parties to the extent necessary to ensure the integrity of the trial process; and
2. Proceedings remotely will not otherwise jeopardize the integrity of the trial process.

The minor voluntarily waives his or her physical appearance in the courtroom.
