Trouble With E-Filing?


If you don't have a lawyer, you may <u>not</u> have to e-file.

Paper filing is an option if you:

- don't have access to a computer with Internet;
- have a disability that makes it hard to e-file;
- have trouble reading or writing in English; or
- are filing an Order for Protection

You must file a Certification for Exemption from E-Filing. Ask the court clerk for a form.
