ORDER AFTER SANCTION HEARING

This matter coming before the Court on a violation of pretrial conditions, pursuant to 725 ILCS5/110-6, the Court finds:

1. That the defendant:

failed to appear in court as required by their conditions of release.
while on pretrial release, was charged with a felony or class A misdemeanor.
while on pretrial release, was charged with a class B or C misdemeanor, petty offense, traffic offense, or ordinance violation.
violated a condition of release set by the court.

2. That the State:

failed to meet the elements as set forth in 725 ILCS 5/110-6(e) by clear and convincing evidence.
proved the allegation(s) by clear and convincing evidence that:

1. The defendant committed an act that violated a term of their pretrial release;
2. The defendant had actual knowledge that their action would violate a court order;
3. The violation of the court order was willful; AND
4. The violation was not caused by a lack of access to financial monetary resources.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

Due to the State's failure to prove a violation of pretrial release, there are no sanctions ordered.

Pursuant to 725 ILCS 5/110-6(f), the defendant is sanctioned as follows:

The defendant received an oral and/or written admonishment from the court.
